Establishing a SEE Sponsored Clinic Location

SEE is a non-profit humanitarian organization whose mission is to restore sight to disadvantaged blind individuals worldwide. We work with ophthalmic surgeons who become "affiliates" of our organization, and then we provide administrative support, donated supplies and possibly loaned equipment for these expeditions usually working with you 3-6 month in advance of a scheduled expedition.

Documentation Checklist:

- Ophthalmology Profile
Assures surgical facility is adequate and provides important information for needs assessment.
- Host ophthalmologist who has become an Affiliate of SEE International
There must be an identified host ophthalmologist who will handle pre-screening of patients for the clinic and post-operative patient care as our teams typically perform surgery during the clinic and then return to the US.
- Traveling ophthalmologists are SEE Affiliates
- Letter of Invitation
SEE International and visiting teams must be invited in to the country by the Ministry of Health or other local health authority. Our goal is to work in tandem with local medical personnel and authorities.
- Allied Health/volunteers (including spouses/family) traveling complete Volunteer Applications
In case of emergency, SEE needs to have all team members' information on file.

You can mail, fax or email these documents to you SEE International Clinic Coordinator.
Documents are due at least two months prior to your clinic dates.
